

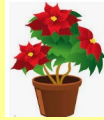
## Computing

## Maths

**Multiplication and division**

- Recall of 3,4 and 8 times table facts
- Recap of multiplication grid method and chunking method

**Weight and volume**

- Measuring and comparing mass (kg/g) and volume/capacity (l/ml)

**Time**

- Recapping number of seconds in a minute and days in each month and year. Telling and writing time and estimating time to the nearest minute

**Place Value**

- Recognising place value of each digit, comparing and ordering numbers, counting from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 59 and 100.

**Fractions**

- Recognising, finding and writing fractions of an amount and shape. Adding and subtracting frac-

## RE

**People of God**

Make clear links between the covenant between Noah and God. Understand the promises Christians make at a wedding. Make connections between our lives and the story of Noah.

**Gospel**

Identify the Gospel tells the story and life of Jesus. Make links between the calling of the disciples of how Christians follow Jesus and be 'fishers of people'. Offer suggestions about Jesus' actions towards the leper.

Learning to listen and appraise songs and explore musical terms such as dynamics, pulse, performance.

## History

**The Victorians**
